Asbestos Reporting Requirements

Asbestos is classified as a hazardous air pollutant by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and is the reason why demolition and renovation projects must comply with certain asbestos requirements before they begin. The Puget Sound Clean Air Agency's regulatory authority covers King, Kitsap, Pierce, and Snohomish counties.

Asbestos Survey

will not accept a demolition notification after the demolition has occurred. You may receive a Notice of Violation from our Agency for failure to notify. Before further disturbing the debris, you must determine whether it contains asbestos material. Obtain the services of an AHERA Building Inspector (look in the yellow pages under "Asbestos") to survey the demolition debris for the presence of asbestos.
